Protein construction description:	A DNA sequence encoding the rat Albumin/ALB protein (P02770) (Glu 25-Ala 608) was expressed with tag free.

Background: Serum albumin (ALB), the main protein in plasma, has a very good binding capacity for water, fatty acids, calcium, sodium, bilirubin, hormones, potassium and drugs. The primary function of ALB is to regulate the colloidal osmotic pressure of blood. Albumin is synthesized in the liver as preproalbumin, which has an N-terminal peptide that is removed before the nascent protein is released from the rough endoplasmic reticulum. The product, proalbumin, is in turn cleaved in the Golgi vesicles to produce the secreted form of albumin. Mutations in the ALB gene may result in familial dysalbuminemic hyperthyroxinemia (FDH), a form of euthyroid hyperthyroxinemia that is due to increased affinity of ALB for T4. FDH is the most common cause of inherited euthyroid hyperthyroxinemia in Caucasian populations.

Purity: >95% as determined by SDS-PAGE.

Endotoxin: Less than 1.0 EU per µg by the LAL method.

Fragment region: Albumin/ALB (25-608)

Predicted molecular mass: 66.7 kD

Formulation: Lyophilized from a 0.2 µm filtered solution of PBS, pH7.4, 5% Trehalose, 5% mannitol.

Reconstitution: Reconstitute at 250 µg/ml in sterile water.

Storage: Please avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. Samples are stable for up to twelve months from date of receipt at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that aliquot the reconstituted solution to minimize freeze-thaw cycles.

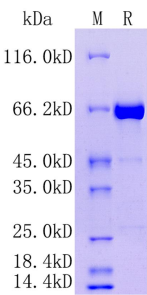


Fig1: Protein on SDS-PAGE under reducing (R) condition.
